

Timpanogos Triathlon Club Constitution

Article I

Club Purpose. Timpanogos Triathlon Club is an organized club dedicated to the educational pursuit of triathlon, general physical fitness, and the representation of the sport of triathlon within the community.

Article II

Club Name. The official name shall be Timpanogos Triathlon Club.

Article III

Club Membership. Membership shall be open to any individual who shares in the common purpose of the Timpanogos Triathlon Club and timely pays the required dues. Membership shall be granted without discrimination upon basis of race, creed, color, religion, age, sex, national origin, and physical or mental handicap.

Article IV

Club Officers. Four officers shall comprise the Timpanogos Triathlon Club Executive Committee. Terms of office are from October 11 until October 10 of the following calendar year. There are no term limits for any office.

Officer Elections. The president shall establish a nominating committee at the July Executive Committee meeting. The nominating committee shall consist of one Executive Committee member and one current club member at large. The committee shall ask for nominations from the floor of the July and August club meetings. The committee shall prepare a slate of officer candidates for presentation at the September meeting for election by the membership at that meeting. All offices shall be filled by a majority vote from the membership present at the club meeting in which the election is scheduled to take place.

Vacancies. Vacancies occurring during the term of office shall be filled by a majority vote of the Executive Committee, subject to ratification by the membership at the next regularly scheduled club meeting.

The offices are:

President – presides over meetings, provides vision and direction, and functions as the primary contact for the club.

Vice President – acts as president in the absence of the president and assists president in his/her duties. Responsible for guest speakers at club meetings.

Secretary – responsible for keeping accurate minutes at Executive Committee and other club meetings. Keeps a current roster of club members.

Treasurer – collects and deposits member dues and other funds paid to the club, pays club debts, and accounts for club's finances with a monthly report.

Article V

Executive Committee. Executive Committee Meetings shall be held as needed as determined by the Executive Committee. Dates and times of Executive Committee meetings and agenda items are to be published in the club's newsletter and/or website.

Article VI

Club Meetings. Club meetings shall be held on the second Tuesday of each month at 6:30 a.m. in the spinning room of the American Fork Recreation Center.

Article VII

Committees. The club will have the following standing committees as well as any ad hoc committees deemed necessary by the Executive Committee for the carrying on of club business and the furtherance of the club's purpose: Constitution; Newsletter; Website; Christmas

Party; Uniforms; Sponsors; T-shirt Design;
Spring Event; Promotion; USAT Membership.

Article VIII

Amendments. Proposed amendments to this Constitution may be recommended to the Executive Committee by any member. The Executive Committee shall consider the proposed amendment, and, at a regularly scheduled club meeting, shall make a recommendation for either its adoption or rejection. Upon a favorable vote from 2/3 of the members present at such meeting, the amendment shall be adopted. All proposed amendments shall be posted in the club newsletter and/or website at least fifteen days before the club meeting in which the proposed amendment will be considered.
